

What does CINAHL Plus with Full Text include?

- Indexing for over 3800 journals in nursing and allied health dating back to 1937
- PreCINAHL, immediate table of contents from 800+ core journals
- 360+ research instrument descriptions, including utilization and validation
- **Evidence-Based Care Sheets** that provide 2-page summaries of treatment care for many conditions and include all references used in producing the summaries
- **Quick Lessons**, providing 2-page summaries with references for diseases and conditions
- Searchable **Cited References** back to 1994 from more than 1700 indexed journals (as compared to less than 70 nursing journals covered by Web of Science)
- Ability to display citations with different styles, e.g. APA
- Stay up to date on subjects using RSS or email alerts
- Save searches in a personalized folder
- Export search results to RefWorks and EndNote

How is CINAHL Plus different from PubMed?

PubMed

- Coverage: 1940's to date
- Indexes 5000 journals
- Includes only citations to journal articles
- Focuses on biomedical literature
- Uses MeSH (Medical Subject Headings) as its controlled vocabulary
- Not possible to identify peer-reviewed journals
- Does not include cited references from the end of articles

CINAHL Plus

- Coverage: 1937 to date
- Indexes 3800 journals in nursing and allied health
- Includes citations to journal articles, book chapters, dissertations, AVs, nurse practice acts, Evidence-Based Care Sheets, research instruments, etc.
- Focuses on nursing and allied health literature
- Based on MeSH with additional CINAHL (nursing and allied health) subject headings
- Peer reviewed journal limit available
- Includes cited references listed at the end of many articles
